

LAUSD releases Preliminary Environmental Assessment on proposed SRHS #15 Site at Ft MacArthur Upper Reservation

Marcela Solórzano, a communication consultant for the Los Angeles Unified School District assisting the District with the community outreach activities related to the presentation of the "Preliminary Environmental Assessment" or PEA for the proposed South Region High School #15 (3200 South Alma Street, San Pedro, CA 90731), announced the release of the document on August 5th.

The PEA consisted of sampling several areas of the vacant school site and analyzing soil samples for chemicals of concern. The results of the sampling and analysis are outlined in a PEA report which is now available to the public for review. The California Department of Toxic Substances Control is supervising the environmental sampling activities at this site and is currently reviewing the PEA report developed by the District.

The notice of the PEA release includes more information about the project, where you can obtain copies of the report and the details of a public meeting that the District will hold on August 20th to present the results of the PEA and to give an opportunity for the community to provide comments on the PEA document.
