

# Who Can Sign the R1 Petition

Here are the simplified rules concerning who can sign the R1 petition.

1. Being a living human being.
2. Being able to read in the English language.
3. Being able to understand what the petition gatherers' ask for.
4. Being able to believe what the petition gatherers' say.
5. Being able to print own name, address, phone number, and email address.
6. Being able to sign their signature.

There are no age, residency, or felony conviction restrictions.

Petition signers do not need to be able to drive, or be a registered voter.

There are no citizenship requirements.

The petition is an informational petition. It may be used to help fight any ordinance proposed by supporters of Bisno Development in conjunction with their attempts to have the current zoning changed from its current zoning to a "specific plan zone".

The petition is to inform Councilwoman Janice Hahn of the 15<sup>th</sup> district of the City of Los Angeles that the signers of the petition demand that the current zoning remain on the Ponte Vista at San Pedro development site.

A secondary use of the petition is to understand how many members of the entire community oppose Bob Bisno's current plans. The information gathered with the petitions will allow the steering committee of R Neighborhoods Are 1 to be able to gauge the public's awareness and opinions concerning the Ponte Vista project.
